



Imperial County Regional Center

In September of 2009, the Imperial County was awarded \$2,500,000 from the U.S. Department of Commerce – Economic Development Administration (EDA) through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Imperial Center project infrastructure improvements. The Imperial Center is a multi-use commercial center located along State Route 111 between Correll Road and Heber Road. The Infrastructure Improvements Project funded the extension of existing potable water and wastewater treatment infrastructure sourced from the Heber Public Utility District (HPUD) to the project. This EDA funding with the Developer funds, provided by James Lo and Pacificland Int. Development, Inc., made the Imperial Center project a reality.

On May 11, 2012 a grand opening ceremony was held where the Imperial Center's first store, the AM/PM convenience store and gas station, was made available to the public. On May 29, 2014, a ribbon cutting ceremony was held at the Wholesale Center, a trading center to purchase merchandise for wholesale. In addition to opening the Wholesale Center, the event also celebrated the grand opening of an event center and four restaurants located at the Imperial Center: Gobi's Mongolian BBQ, Joy Seafood Grill, Marino's Italian Bistro, and the Twin Dragon Chinese Restaurant.

Continuing with the development of the Imperial Center, the next phase in the plans consists of a hotel and retail center
